- 4. Approximately what percentage of the new admitted TE candidates at your institution were offered a TE scholarship for the upcoming academic year:
 - Not receiving new import candidates for 2015-2016
 - O%-10%
 - **11%-40%**
 - **41%-60%**
 - 61%-90%
 - Usually all or most of the qualified candidates receive an award offer
 - a. You need to collect the following information:
 - i. Total number of TE applications received by the school
 - ii. Total number of above who applied for admission to the school
 - iii. Total number of the above admitted to the school
 - iv. Total number of admitted students who were offered a TE award
 - v. Actual number of awarded TE students who actually enrolled

We encourage you to keep these numbers on record in case there are families who question them. By all using the same formula there should be less confusion.

For example

- i. 165 TE applications
- ii. 105 of the 165 actually applied
- iii. 80 of the 105 were admitted
- iv. 60 of the 80 were offered
- v. 40 of the 60 enrolled

And the answer is: 75% or in the box above you will select the 61% to 90% option.
