Skidmore College joined the Tuition Exchange (TE) in April 1992. The 2019-2020 academic year marks the College's 28th year of membership. An overview of the College's TE imports and exports is provided below.

Import Activity: Students who receive a Tuition Exchange Scholarship (TES) from Skidmore to attend Skidmore are called "imports".

## 2018-2019 Academic Year

44 students enrolled September 2018 with TES. The dollar value of each TES was $\$ 18,000$ per semester.

## 2019-2020 Academic Year

137 prospective first-years completed TE applications
74 of 137 applied for admission to Skidmore
45 of 74 were offered admission
23 of 45 were offered admission and TES
7 of 23 enrolled September 2019 with TES

36 returning students enrolled September 2019 with TES

In summary, 43 students enrolled for the 2019-2020 academic year with TES - 7 freshmen, 9 sophomores, 12 juniors and 15 seniors. TES students are from Connecticut, Georgia, Indiana, Kentucky, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island and Vermont. The dollar value of each TES is \$18,500 per semester.

Export Activity: Dependents of eligible Skidmore employees who receive TES to attend participating TE institutions are called "exports".

## 2018-2019 Academic Year

53 students enrolled with TES at participating institutions

## 2019-2020 Academic Year

38 renewal applications for TE certification were submitted, 38 out of 38 were offered a renewal TES, 33 re-enrolled with TE 31 new faculty/staff dependents applied for TE

24 were first year applicants, 21 of the 24 were offered TE at one or more institution
7 were transfer or currently enrolled without TE applicants, 3 of 7 were offered TE at one or more institution

In summary, 48 students enrolled for the 2019-2020 academic year with TES at participating TE institutions - 14 freshmen, 16 sophomores, 7 juniors and 11 seniors.

Overall there were 5 more exports than imports for the 2019/2020 academic year.
